Siner Shines at Comedy Connection

EAST PROVIDENCE, RI – Local musician, [Pete Siner](#), performed at The Comedy Connection; a rare feat for a singer/songwriter. Siner opened up for comedians on Thursday, May 26th, during *Comedy for Our Communities*—a fundraiser put on by the [Children’s Workshop Foundation](#). He played for a crowd of over 200 patrons, all eagerly awaiting song after song.

Making his debut in 2014, Siner has come a long way in such a short period of time. Teaching himself to play the guitar through YouTube videos, the process has come full circle, as [his music](#) can now be found on that exact site. From [cover songs](#) to incredibly catchy [originals](#), Siner has a sound similar to that of the popular band, [The Lumineers](#).

His set list for the night of *Comedy for Our Communities* included originals, “Tonight”, “You”, “Towards It”, “More”, “The End”, and “Our Way Back”, and covers including “Ophelia” off of The Lumineers’ sophomore album, *Cleopatra*, and “I Will Wait” by popular folk band, Mumford & Sons.

Though Siner is most prevalent on the local scene, playing [public venues](#) such as The Whiskey Republic in Providence, The Thirsty Beaver in both Cranston and Smithfield, and Federal Taphouse in Providence, he has also performed in Nashville, Tennessee and Anaheim, California—more specifically, at the [NAMM](#) (National Association of Music Merchants) show.
